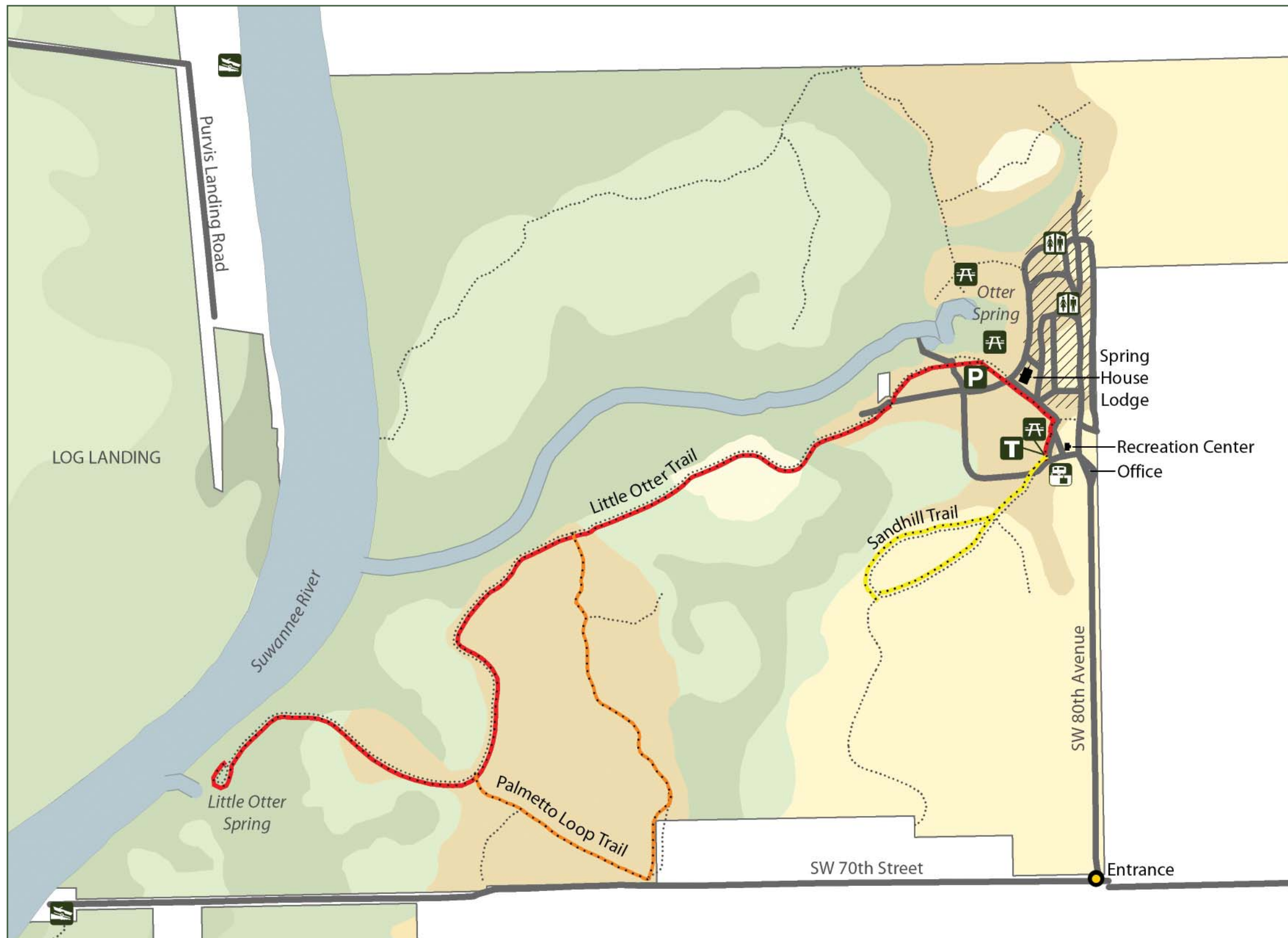

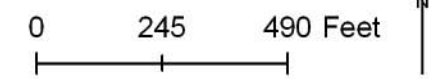


Park Guidelines

- Campground speed limit is 5 mph. Park drive (SW 80th Avenue) speed limit is 10 mph.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. until 8 a.m. Sunday through Thursday; 11 p.m. until 8 a.m. Friday and Saturday.
- ATVs cannot be operated within the park. Golf carts are allowed; please ask for special rules.
- Pets must be on a leash and are not permitted inside any building or swimming area. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- Parents are responsible for the safety and behavior of their children at all times.
- Children 16 and under must wear a helmet when riding a bicycle.
- Smoking is not permitted inside any park building. Please do not throw cigarette butts on the ground or in fire rings.
- Fires are allowed in pre-approved fire rings only when weather conditions are safe for burning.
- Canoes are available to rent at the park office.
- Fishing is allowed by the canoe launch and in spring run only. No fishing in swimming area.
- Please be considerate of other visitors so everyone can enjoy their stay.
